7th Principle tip: Have you been admiring the soft, silky "hand" of bamboo fabrics made into products like bath towels and sheets? Think that's because growing bamboo is a reasonably sustainable industry that you are being 'green' by buying items made from these fabrics? Nope. Bamboo fabric is made using the same viscose process that produces rayon. Cellulose such as bamboo is dissolved in a carbon disulfide solution, a (surprise) toxic chemical; the solution is then extruded through spinnerets into a 'quenching' solution that hardens it. The problem lies in the fact that 'recovery of this solvent in most viscose factories is around 50%, which means that the other half goes into the environment.' (Patagonia.com, Footprint Chronicles) Perhaps that's why it is all made overseas. It is possible but a good deal more expensive to create a 'closed loop' process, such as the one that Tencel fabric is made from.
